Bushberg receives alumni award from Purdue University

Jerrold Bushberg, clinical professor of radiology and director of Health Physics Programs, has been selected as Purdue University's 2016 John Christian Distinguished Alumni in Health Sciences.

Bushberg's selection for the award is based on his "outstanding record of academic and professional accomplishments," according to Purdue University. It is the highest honor awarded by the School of Health Sciences and was established in 1988.

The award is made possible by an endowment in honor of John E. Christian, the Hovde Distinguished Service Professor of Bionucleonics and Health Sciences at Purdue. Christian was the first head of the Health Sciences School, and retired from the university in 1988.

The award is scheduled to be presented on Oct. 6, 2016.
